***Things you need to know:***

- **STAGING LOCATION** is again at **THE SWEETENS PROPERTY** AT 20138 LELAND ROAD, OREGON CITY, OREGON 97045
- Dualsport course will consist of A, B, & C options. Adventure course will be the C course (but extended), consisting of gravel, dirt and paved roads.
- **This is NOT a race**, but a fun, EZ-to-follow, on/off-road, leisurely, and scenic rider through the Willamette Valley area.  
Quiet mufflers are mandatory and can only help our sport! Nothing acceptable above 96db!
- **All Bikes must be street legal.**
- Sign up begins at 8:00am. Riders leave at 9:30am. Last rider out will be 10:30am.
- Be sure to bring an Enduro type roll chart holder to facilitate your roll chart. Highly recommended! We may have a few available for sale.
- Course instructions will be by accurate roll chart, and ribbons.  
The roll chart instructions will consist of mileage displayed in tenths/hundredths of a mile with turn instructions. Odometer resets will be approximately every 10+ miles to accommodate for speedometer error. Course is laid out with an enduro computer for ultimate accuracy to 1/100th of a mile.
- Prizes will be awarded by accumulated points earned on games of chance at checkpoints.
- Main (B) course will consist of EZ dirt roads with pavement kept to an absolute minimum. This event caters to ALL manor of dualsport & adventure bikes, whether it's a large BMW GS or a small trailbikes.  
**Trailriding skills are required** for the dualsport course. Optional advanced challenging trail sections throughout the event will be available for the hardcore dual-sporters who want more of a venture.

**Here's a helpful check-off list of things to do before showing up for this event:**

- Bring a gas can with gas to store in your truck, for some spare!
- Mount a [rollchart holder](#) on left side of your handlebars.
- Bring raingear (This is Oregon, so you never know!).
- Make sure you have your state's current OHV sticker in place. (We will sell them during sign-up)
- Pack a good assortment of tools in your fanny pack for unforeseen, trail repairs. Also put a few dollars in your fanny pack just in case.
- Be sure to carry items to repair a flat tire.
- Keep some water with you in your pack.
- Be sure your [spark arrestor/muffler](#) is **QUIET!** Loud bikes - stay home!
- Do that maintenance on your bike that you keep putting off: check nuts/bolts, oil, air filter, tires, chain...
