A colored bar (2"x4" colored sticker) will be issued to indicate you are a competitor. This colored bar is to be placed directly under your front number. The colored bar will be mailed to you along with your OMRA card.

2. Proof of age (example, photocopy of your driver's license).
3. Minors are to have an original notary signed statement from their parents or guardian allowing them to race this season.

Class Definitions:

- **Beginner class:** absolute beginner or novice. *Raced only a few times.* Don't have a desire to bang handlebars- **just have fun** and finish.
- **Amateur class:** intermediate-level riders. *Raced more than a few times.* Can get up most hills on single track on the first try. Looking for challenges in the course and competitive in spirit. Most, **but not all**, 2006 amateur class racers belong here.
- **Expert class:** expert-level riders. Raced a bunch. Solid bike skills. Looking for fast competition and very challenging terrain. Most, **but not all**, experts from 2006 belong in this class.
- **AA class:** AA, or best-of-the-best level riders in other racing series. Live to race. Want to win. **Have proven yourself in the expert ranks. If you can finish in the top ten overall at an OMRA event, this is your class! The top six overall from the previous year earn this designation automatically.**
